#### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to amend sections 44-2825 and

  44-2832, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change

  recovery amounts under the Nebraska Hospital-Medical

  Liability Act; and to repeal the original sections.
- Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 44-2825, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 44-2825 (1) (1) (a) The total amount recoverable under the
- 4 Nebraska Hospital-Medical Liability Act from any and all health
- 5 care providers and the Excess Liability Fund for any occurrence
- 6 resulting in any injury or death of a patient may not exceed
- 7 (a) (i) five hundred thousand dollars for any occurrence on or
- 8 before December 31, 1984, (b) (ii) one million dollars for any
- 9 occurrence after December 31, 1984, and on or before December 31,
- 10 1992, (e) (iii) one million two hundred fifty thousand dollars for
- 11 any occurrence after December 31, 1992, and on or before December
- 12 31, 2003, and (d) (iv) one million seven hundred fifty thousand
- 13 dollars for any occurrence after December 31, 2003, and on or
- 14 before December 31, 2010.
- 15 (b) For occurrences after December 31, 2010, for any
- 16 occurrence resulting in any injury or death of a patient under the
- 17 act, for damages recoverable from health care providers and the
- 18 Excess Liability Fund in a settlement or judgment:
- 19 (i) The amount of economic damages is unlimited;
- 20 (ii) (A) If there are no economic damages, the amount of
- 21 noneconomic damages recoverable is one million seven hundred fifty
- 22 thousand dollars or less;
- 23 (B) If there are economic damages of less than one
- 24 million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars, the amount of
- 25 noneconomic damages recoverable shall be the difference between

1 one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars and the amount of

- 2 economic damages; and
- 3 (C) If there are economic damages of one million seven
- 4 hundred fifty thousand dollars or more, no noneconomic damages are
- 5 recoverable.
- 6 (c) For purposes of this section, economic damages
- 7 and noneconomic damages have the same meaning as in section
- 8 25-21,185.08.
- 9 (2) A health care provider qualified under the act shall
- 10 not be liable to any patient or his or her representative who
- 11 is covered by the act for an amount in excess of five hundred
- 12 thousand dollars for all claims or causes of action arising from
- 13 any occurrence during the period that the act is effective with
- 14 reference to such patient.
- 15 (3) Subject to the overall limits from all sources as
- 16 provided in subsection (1) of this section, any amount due from a
- 17 judgment or settlement which is in excess of the total liability
- 18 of all liable health care providers shall be paid from the Excess
- 19 Liability Fund pursuant to sections 44-2831 to 44-2833.
- 20 Sec. 2. Section 44-2832, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 21 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 22 44-2832 (1) The Director of Administrative Services shall
- 23 issue a warrant drawn on the fund in the amount of each claim
- 24 submitted by the director. All claims against the fund shall be
- 25 made on a voucher or other appropriate request by the director

- 1 after he or she has received:
- 2 (a) A certified copy of a final judgment in excess of
- 3 five hundred thousand dollars against a health care provider and in
- 4 excess of the amount recoverable from all health care providers;
- 5 (b) A certified copy of a court-approved settlement in
- 6 excess of five hundred thousand dollars against a health care
- 7 provider and in excess of the amount recoverable from all health
- 8 care providers; or
- 9 (c) In case of claims based on primary insurance issued
- 10 by the risk manager under sections 44-2837 to 44-2839, a certified
- 11 copy of a final judgment or court-approved settlement requiring
- 12 payment from the fund.
- 13 (2) The amount paid from the fund for excess liability
- 14 when added to the payments by all health care providers may not
- 15 exceed the maximum amount recoverable pursuant to subsection (1)
- 16 of section 44-2825. The amount paid from the fund on account of
- 17 a primary insurance policy issued by the risk manager to a health
- 18 care provider under sections 44-2837 to 44-2839 may not exceed five
- 19 hundred thousand dollars for any one occurrence covered by such
- 20 policy under any circumstances. for noneconomic damages.
- 21 Sec. 3. Original sections 44-2825 and 44-2832, Reissue
- 22 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
