Section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative 1 2 Supplement, 2008, is amended to read: 3 60-601 Sections 60-601 to 60-6,377 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Rules of the 4 5 Road. Sec. 2. (1) It shall be unlawful for an individual to 6 7 operate or be an occupant in a motor vehicle while smoking if an 8 individual under sixteen years of age is an occupant in the motor 9 vehicle. Violation of this section shall result in a fine of at 10 least fifty dollars but not to exceed one hundred fifty dollars. 11 (2) An individual fined under subsection (1) of this 12 section may voluntarily participate, at his or her own expense, in 13 a smoking cessation program approved by the Department of Health 14 and Human Services, and such fine shall be refunded upon successful 15 completion of the program. 16 (3) Any peace officer who has been duly authorized to 17 make arrests for violations of traffic laws of this state or of 18 ordinances of any city or village may stop a motor vehicle if the 19 officer has a clear and unobstructed view of any individual smoking 20 as prohibited in subsection (1) of this section. The officer may 21 issue a citation pursuant to subsection (1) of this section for a 22 primary offense. (4) A citation issued under this section shall not become 23 part of the individual's driving record. Violation of this section 24 25 shall not constitute prima facie evidence of negligence. (5) For purposes of this section, smoke or smoking has 4 the same meaning as in section 71-5727. 5 6 Sec. 3. Original section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2008, is repealed. 7
