- 8 III-10 Beginning with the year 1975, regular sessions of
- 9 the Legislature shall be held annually, commencing at 10 a.m. on
- 10 the first Wednesday after the first Monday in January of each year.
- 11 The duration of regular sessions held shall not exceed ninety sixty
- 12 legislative days in odd-numbered years unless extended by a vote of
- 13 four-fifths of all members elected to the Legislature, and shall
- 14 not exceed sixty forty legislative days in even-numbered years
- 15 unless extended by a vote of four-fifths of all members elected

1 the Legislature upon adjournment of a regular session held in an odd-numbered year may be considered at the next regular session, 2 3 as if there had been no such adjournment. The Lieutenant Governor shall preside, but shall vote only when the Legislature is equally 4 5 divided. A majority of the members elected to the Legislature shall 6 constitute a quorum; the Legislature shall determine the rules 7 of its proceedings and be the judge of the election, returns, 8 and qualifications of its members, shall choose its own officers, 9 including a Speaker to preside when the Lieutenant Governor shall 10 be absent, incapacitated, or shall act as Governor. No member shall 11 be expelled except by a vote of two-thirds of all members elected 12 to the Legislature, and no member shall be twice expelled for the 13 same offense. The Legislature may punish by imprisonment any person not a member thereof who shall be guilty of disrespect to the 14 15 Legislature by disorderly or contemptuous behavior in its presence, 16 but no such imprisonment shall extend beyond twenty-four hours at
