LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 461

Introduced by Cook, 13; McGill, 26.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this study is to examine the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 as it relates to parking accessibility for handicapped or disabled persons. The study should include Nebraska statutes, rules, and regulations governing handicapped and disabled parking permits and business practices relating to parking spaces for handicapped or disabled persons. Specific attention should be given to obstructions such as snow piles, flower sales, construction equipment, and trash containers which are placed in handicapped parking spaces which violate statutory requirements that such spaces be exclusively used for parking by handicapped or disabled persons. The study should include recommendations for enforcement of accessibility of such parking spaces and removal of obstructions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Urban Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
