

## One Hundred First Legislature - First Session - 2009 Introducer's Statement of Intent LB 443

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 443 would promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the people of the state by establishing reasonable regulations to prevent the deleterious secondary effects of adult businesses and sexually oriented businesses.

LB 443 would regulate the time of operation of adult businesses and sexually oriented businesses, regulate the minimal distance allowed between an employee in a state of sexually explicit nudity or seminudity and a patron, and prohibit the touching of an employee in a state of sexually explicit nudity or seminudity by a patron or the touching of a patron by such an employee.

In addition, the bill would put in place a quarter of a mile distance requirement from a child care facility, a private or public school, a public playground, a public recreational facility, a residence, or a place of worship for all new adult businesses and sexually oriented businesses after the effective date of this act.
