The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of this bill is to allow children currently in guardianships to be placed in permanent adoptive homes as prescribed.

LB91 would 1) allow a state subsidized adoption when there has been a subsidized guardianship, and existing guardian is adopting; and 2) allow the assistance provided under subsidized adoption to mirror the subsidized guardianship assistance.

- This bill will allow some guardians to adopt the child, providing the following criteria are met:
 - Adoption ends the court's involvement.
 - All family members are assured of a higher degree of permanency, because the guardian assumes full parental rights and responsibilities, and the child becomes a legal member of the family; and
 - Neither parent nor child faces the danger of a birth parent or another person petitioning for custody or visitation rights.
