**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

Current law requires a direct gift, bequest or devise to a state agency of real property, a structure, or an improvement to go through an approval process prior to acceptance. LB 264 expands the approval process to include acquisition of such property using proceeds from a donation, gift, bequest, devise, or grant from an individual, an organization, a corporation, a foundation, or a similar entity or from a nonfederal governmental agency.
