LB 312 is the Brain Injury Act. The bill establishes a fifteen member Brain Injury Council to provide assistance and support to the State Department of Education (NDE) in the implementation of the act. A Veterans Resource Facilitation Fund is created for use by the Division of Rehabilitation Services at NDE to administer the act. Money in the fund shall be utilized by the division to fund resource facilitators and to fund the expenses of the Brain Injury Council.

NDE indicates the department has a federal traumatic brain injury grant for infrastructure that can be used to fund the annual expenses of the council and provide reimbursement of members for necessary expenses in FY2011-12 and FY2012-13. However, the grant cannot be used for direct services.

Since there is no revenue source identified for the Veterans Resource Facilitation Fund, NDE estimates an additional \$83,187 of general fund expenditures will be required in FY2011-12 and \$84,874 in FY2012-13 to hire one resource facilitator to facilitate services for veterans with brain injuries.

DEPT. OF EDUCATION – The fiscal impact appears to be only \$15,000 in order to fund the administration of the Council, i.e. reimbursement of member travel expenses. Any support for the Brain Injury Act by the Department of Education could be performed with existing staff for no additional resources.

LB 312 appears to be identical to LB 141 (101st Legislature, 2009). Both would establish the Veterans Resource Facilitation Fund, which is to be used to fund the costs attributable to this legislation. However, the bill language does not offer any intent nor establish any revenue generation methods for this Fund. Furthermore, the Department's fiscal notes for each bill are different with regard to sources of funding and items of cost.

In the LB 141 fiscal note, the Department identified \$15,000 in federal funds for administration costs of the Traumatic Brain Injury Council. Neither the cost nor the availability of federal funds is identified in the LB 312 fiscal note.

In LB 141, the Department also identified a need for 1.0 FTE to serve as "resource facilitator" in accordance with the definitions in the bill. It estimated an FY 2010 General Fund cost of \$60,000. The 1.0 FTE cost has increased two years later to \$83,187, which the Department now describes as a "program director".
