This bill repeals the requirement that child care reimbursement rates be based on the market rate survey that is conducted every other year. Currently the rates must be set at a level between the 60th and 75th percentile of the market rate survey.

Under this bill child care rates could be set at any level. Current law requires rates to be set at least at the 60^{th} percentile. Based on the most recent market rate survey, an additional \$2,808,923 is needed each year. With this bill, the rates would be set at the level of the appropriation provided for this purpose. This bill was introduced at the request of the Governor. His budget recommendation assumed rates would be flat for FY 12 and FY 13. The Appropriations Committee did not include the \$2,808,923 in their preliminary recommendation.
