A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to fees; to amend section 33-110, Reissue Revised
- 2 Statutes of Nebraska; to change certain county clerk
- 3 fees; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 33-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 33-110 County clerks shall receive no fee for the
4 performance of the following services: For issuing certificates of
5 election; for performing the duties of clerk of the county board; for
6 taking acknowledgments of claims against the county; for attesting or
7 certifying any document authorized by the county board or required by
8 the departments of the state; or for recording Army or Navy
9 discharges or furnishing certified copies thereof to be used in
10 connection with any claim for compensation or disability. A charge of
11 twenty-five cents shall be made for any other certificate and seal
12 unless otherwise provided. The fees collected shall be credited to
13 the county general fund.

14 County clerks shall receive a fee of ~~fifteen~~thirty
15 dollars for the entire proceedings of issuing a marriage license,
16 administering the related oaths or affirmations, and recording a
17 marriage certificate. An additional fee of ~~five~~seven dollars shall
18 be made for each certified copy of a marriage record on file in the
19 office of the county clerk. Both such fees shall be deposited in the
20 county general fund.
