5		provide for certain motorboats and trailers to be
6		considered abandoned; to harmonize provisions; and to
7		repeal the original sections.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 37-1299, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 37-1299 (1) A motorboat is and the trailer upon which the 4 motorboat rests, if any, are abandoned: 5 (a) If left unattended for more than seven days on any 6 public property; 7 (b) If left unattended for more than seven days on 8 private property if left initially without permission of the owner; 9 (c) If left for more than seven days on private property after permission of the owner is terminated; or 10 11 (d) If they are inoperable, partially dismantled, 12 wrecked, junked, or discarded and they are left unattended and 13 visible to the public for more than thirty days on private property which is within a municipality or its extraterritorial zoning 14 jurisdiction and which is not a junkyard as defined in section 15 16 39-2602; or 17 (d) (e) If left for more than thirty days in the custody of a law enforcement agency after the agency has sent a letter to the 18 last-registered owner under section 37-12,102. 19 20 (2) For purposes of this section: 21 (a) Public property means any public park, waterfront, or 22 other state, county, or municipally owned property; and 23 (b) Private property means any privately owned property which is not included within the definition of public property. 24 25 (3) No motorboat or trailer subject to forfeiture under

section 28-431 shall be deemed abandoned under this section. 1 2 (4) No motorboat shall be deemed inoperable or partially 3 dismantled if the motor is maintained according to the manufacturer's 4 recommendations for storage. 5 Sec. 2. Section 37-12,100, Reissue Revised Statutes of б Nebraska, is amended to read: 7 37-12,100 If an abandoned motorboat, at the time of 8 $abandonment_{\tau}$ an abandoned motorboat has no hull identification number affixed and is of a wholesale value, taking into consideration the 9 condition of the motorboat, of two hundred fifty dollars or less, and 10 the trailer upon which the motorboat rests, if any, has no license 11 12 plate affixed and is of a wholesale value, taking into consideration 13 the condition of the trailer, of two hundred fifty dollars or less, title shall immediately vest in the local authority or state agency 14 15 having jurisdiction thereof as provided in section 37-12,103. Any 16 certificate of title issued under this section to the local authority or state agency shall be issued at no cost to such authority or 17 18 agency. Sec. 3. Section 37-12,101, Reissue Revised Statutes of 19 20 Nebraska, is amended to read: 37-12,101 (1) Except for motorboats and trailers covered 21 22 by section 37-12,100, the local authority or state agency having 23 custody of an abandoned motorboat and the trailer upon which the motorboat rests, if any, shall make an inquiry concerning the last-24 25 registered owner of such motorboat and trailer to the Department of

1 Motor Vehicles.

2 (2) The local authority or state agency shall notify the last-registered owner, if any, that the motorboat and trailer, if 3 any, in question has been determined to be abandoned and that, if 4 5 unclaimed, either (a) it they will be sold or will be offered at public auction after five days from the date such notice was mailed 6 7 or (b) title will vest in the local authority or state agency thirty 8 days after the date such notice was mailed. If the Department of Motor Vehicles also notifies the local authority or state agency that 9 a lien or mortgage exists, such notice shall also be sent to the 10 lienholder or mortgagee. Any person claiming such motorboat or 11 12 trailer shall be required to pay the cost of removal and storage of 13 such motorboat or trailer.

14 (3) Title to an abandoned motorboat or trailer, if unclaimed, shall vest in the local authority or state agency (a) five 15 days after the date the notice is mailed if the motorboat or trailer 16 will be sold or offered at public auction under subdivision (2)(a) of 17 18 this section, (b) thirty days after the date the notice is mailed if 19 the local authority or state agency will retain the motorboat or 20 trailer, or (c) if the last-registered owner cannot be ascertained, when notice of such fact is received. 21

(4) After title to the abandoned motorboat <u>and trailer</u>,
<u>if any</u>, vests pursuant to subsection (3) of this section, the local
authority or state agency may retain for use, sell, or auction the
abandoned motorboat <u>or trailer</u>. If the local authority or state

agency has determined that the motorboat or trailer should be 1 2 retained for use, the local authority or state agency shall, at the same time that the notice, if any, is mailed, publish in a newspaper 3 of general circulation in the jurisdiction an announcement that the 4 5 local authority or state agency intends to retain the abandoned vehicle motorboat or trailer for its use and that title will vest in 6 7 the local authority or state agency thirty days after the 8 publication.

9 Sec. 4. Section 37-12,102, Reissue Revised Statutes of
10 Nebraska, is amended to read:

11 37-12,102 A state or local law enforcement agency which 12 has custody of a motorboat and the trailer upon which the motorboat 13 rests, if any, for investigatory purposes and has no further need to keep it the motorboat or trailer in custody shall send a certified 14 letter to each of the last-registered owners stating that the 15 motorboat is and trailer, if any, are in the custody of the law 16 enforcement agency, that the motorboat is and trailer, if any, are no 17 longer needed for law enforcement purposes, and that after thirty 18 days the agency will dispose of the motorboat and trailer. This 19 20 section shall not apply to a motorboat or trailer subject to forfeiture under section 28-431. No storage fees shall be assessed 21 against the registered owner of a motorboat or trailer held in 22 custody for investigatory purposes under this section unless the 23 registered owner or the person in possession of the motorboat or 24 trailer when it is they are taken into custody is charged with a 25

1 felony or misdemeanor related to the offense for which the law 2 enforcement agency took the motorboat <u>and trailer</u> into custody. If a 3 registered owner or the person in possession of the motorboat <u>and</u> 4 <u>trailer</u> when <u>it is they are</u> taken into custody is charged with a 5 felony or misdemeanor but is not convicted, the registered owner 6 shall be entitled to a refund of the storage fees.

8 Nebraska, is amended to read:

9 37-12,103 If a state agency caused an abandoned motorboat 10 and the trailer upon which the motorboat rests, if any, described in subdivision $\frac{(1)(d)}{(1)(e)}$ of section 37-1299 to be removed from 11 12 public property, the state agency shall be entitled to custody of the 13 motorboat and trailer. If a state agency caused an abandoned motorboat and the trailer upon which the motorboat rests, if any, 14 15 described in subdivision (1)(a), (b), or (c), or (d) of section 16 37-1299 to be removed from public property, the state agency shall deliver the motorboat and trailer to the local authority which shall 17 18 have custody. The local authority entitled to custody of an abandoned motorboat and trailer shall be the county in which the motorboat was 19 20 and trailer were abandoned or, if abandoned in a city or village, the 21 city or village in which the motorboat was and trailer were 22 abandoned.

2 37-12,107 No person other than one authorized by the 3 appropriate local authority or state agency shall destroy, deface, or 4 remove any part of a motorboat <u>or trailer upon which a motorboat</u> 5 <u>rests, if any, which is left unattended on a highway or other public</u> 6 place without a hull identification number affixed or which is 7 abandoned. Anyone violating this section is guilty of a Class V 8 misdemeanor.

17 37-12,109 The Director of Motor Vehicles may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations providing for such forms and 18 procedures as are necessary or desirable to effectuate sections 19 20 37-1299 to 37-12,110. Such rules and regulations may include procedures for the removal and disposition of hull identification 21 numbers of abandoned motorboats, forms for local records for 22 23 abandoned motorboats and trailers, and inquiries relating to ownership of such motorboats and trailers. 24
