1 Section 1. Section 28-913, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-913 (1) A person commits an offense if he or she
- 4 unlawfully introduces within a detention facility, or unlawfully
- 5 provides an inmate with, any weapon, tool, or other thing which may
- 6 be useful for escape or provides an inmate with any article
- 7 prohibited by law, regulation, or order of the detaining authority.
- 8 An inmate commits an offense if he or she unlawfully procures, makes,
- 9 or otherwise provides himself $\underline{\text{or herself}}$ with, or has in his $\underline{\text{or her}}$
- 10 possession, any such implement of escape or prohibited article.
- 11 Unlawfully means surreptitiously or contrary to law, regulation, or
- 12 order of the detaining authority.
- 13 (2) Introducing escape implements or any article
- 14 prohibited by law, regulation, or order of the detaining authority is
- 15 a Class I misdemeanor.
