- FOR AN ACT relating to the Department of Administrative Services; to 1 2 amend section 81-1174, Revised Statutes Cumulative 3 Supplement, 2010; to change requirements for the reimbursement of expenses as prescribed; and to repeal 5 the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-1174, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:
- 3 81-1174 (1) Whenever any state officer, state employee,
- 4 or member of any commission, council, committee, or board of the
- 5 state is seeking reimbursement for actual expenses incurred by him or
- 6 her in the line of duty, he or she shall be required to present a
- 7 request for payment or reimbursement to the Director of
- 8 Administrative Services not later than sixty days after the final day
- 9 on which expenses were incurred for which reimbursement is sought.
- 10 Each Except as provided in subsection (5) of this section, each
- 11 request shall be fully itemized, including the amount, date, place,
- 12 and essential character of the expense incurred.
- 13 <u>(2)</u> When reimbursement is requested for mileage by
- 14 automobile, air travel by commercial carrier, air travel in airplanes
- 15 chartered by the department or agency, or air travel by personally
- 16 rented airplane, the points between which such travel occurred, the
- 17 times of arrival and departure, and the necessity and purpose of such
- 18 travel shall be stated on such request. When reimbursement is
- 19 requested for mileage by automobile, the motor vehicle license plate
- 20 number, the total miles traveled, and the rate per mile being
- 21 requested shall also be shown on each request.
- 22 <u>(3) The Accounting Administrator may require less</u>
- 23 supporting detail for requests covered in this section but shall not
- 24 impose reporting requirements which exceed those listed unless
- 25 specifically authorized by other provisions of law. No request shall

1 be submitted by an individual for an expense when such expense has

- 2 been paid by the agency or department concerned.
- 3 <u>(4) When reimbursement for expenses incurred in air</u>
- 4 travel by privately owned airplane is requested, the cost of
- 5 operating the airplane at rates per mile as established by the
- 6 Department of Administrative Services shall be shown on such request.
- 7 Travel by privately owned airplane or personally rented airplane
- 8 shall only be authorized when it is more economical than surface
- 9 transportation or will result in a substantial savings of expense or
- 10 productive time.
- 11 The—(5) When reimbursement is requested for less than
- 12 <u>five consecutive days' expenses, the</u> statement of expenses shall be
- 13 duly verified and supported by receipts for all of such expenditures,
- 14 except immaterial items identified by the director, for which
- 15 reimbursement is requested. When reimbursement is requested for five
- 16 consecutive days or more of expenses, no receipts shall be required
- 17 to accompany the statement of expenses, except to verify any
- 18 miscellaneous expenses other than those for travel, lodging, and
- 19 meals. Reimbursement for travel, lodging, and meals for five
- 20 <u>consecutive days or more shall be determined using the per diem rates</u>
- 21 established by the Department of Administrative Services in
- 22 reimbursing such expenses.
- 23 <u>(6) No charge for mileage shall be allowed when such</u>
- 24 mileage accrues while using an automobile owned by the State of
- 25 Nebraska.

1 (7) No personal maintenance expenses shall be allowed to 2 any state officer, state employee, or member of any commission, 3 council, committee, or board of the state when such expenses are 4 incurred in the city or town in which the residence or primary work 5 location of such individual is located, except that individuals 6 required to attend official functions, conferences, or hearings 7 within such location, not to include normal day-to-day operations of 8 the department, agency, commission, council, committee, or board, may 9 be paid or reimbursed in accordance with policies established by the Director of Administrative Services. The approval to attend a 10 11 function, conference, or hearing shall be obtained from the director 12 of the department, agency, commission, council, committee, or board 13 prior to an individual's attendance at such function, conference, or 14 hearing. 15 Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the furnishing of coffee, tea, and any similar beverage by the 16 17 Legislature or the Legislative Council to its employees or guests.
