A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to oil pipelines; to adopt the Oil Pipeline
- 2 Indemnity Bond Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 4 of this act shall be known and

- 2 may be cited as the Oil Pipeline Indemnity Bond Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. <u>The Legislature finds that:</u>
- 4 (1) Nebraska has the authority as a sovereign state to
- 5 protect its natural resources for economic and environmental purposes
- 6 for the benefit of its residents and future generations;
- 7 (2) Nebraska has a reasonable interest in protecting the
- 8 historical and cultural identity of its land and population;
- 9 (3) Nebraska has a reasonable interest in maximizing land
- 10 <u>utilization and minimizing interference with land use by others,</u>
- insofar as to protect the state's land-use plan;
- 12 (4) Nebraska has a reasonable interest in protecting and
- 13 preserving populations, land and geological structures and
- 14 formations, natural resources, and land quality;
- 15 <u>(5) Ground water in Nebraska will become increasingly</u>
- 16 valuable, both economically and strategically, as the population of
- 17 the world grows;
- 18 (6) The construction of an oil pipeline across Nebraska
- 19 may be necessary to meet international energy needs; and
- 20 <u>(7) Construction and execution of a oil pipeline</u>
- 21 transportation system pose an unforeseeable risk to economic and
- 22 <u>land-use plans for Nebraska.</u>
- Sec. 3. For purposes of the Oil Pipeline Indemnity Bond
- 24 <u>Act:</u>
- 25 (1) Indemnity bond means a surety bond issued by a bank,

1 financial institution, or insurance company to quarantee satisfactory

- 2 response to accidental or intentional harm or injury to land,
- 3 <u>infrastructure</u>, or natural resources;
- 4 (2) Oil means petroleum, including crude oil or any
- 5 <u>fraction thereof</u>;
- 6 (3) Oil pipeline means a pipeline which is larger than
- 7 twenty-five inches of inside diameter and which is constructed either
- 8 partially or wholly within Nebraska for the purpose of transportation
- 9 of oil; and
- 10 (4) Pipeline carrier means a person that engages in
- 11 owning, operating, or managing an oil pipeline.
- 12 Sec. 4. A pipeline carrier who has been granted any
- 13 controlling federal or state order, permit, or authority shall file
- 14 proof of indemnity bond in the amount of five hundred million dollars
- 15 with the Secretary of State at least ninety days prior to the
- 16 construction, laying, relaying, operation, and maintenance of the oil
- 17 pipeline or the location of any plant or equipment necessary to
- 18 operate the oil pipeline. The indemnity bond shall be made available
- 19 to landowners and counties to restore, by payment, any damages to
- 20 <u>land</u>, infrastructure, or natural resources.
