LEGISLATIVE BILL 820A

Introduced by Campbell, 25.

Read first time March 05, 2012

A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in
2 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 820, One
3 Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012; and to
4 declare an emergency.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$115,400 from
2 the General Fund and \$4,000 from federal funds for FY2012-13 and (2)
3 \$123,400 from the General Fund and \$6,000 from federal funds for
4 FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program
5 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 820,
6 One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

7 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
8 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
9 exceed \$71,000 for FY2012-13 or \$71,000 for FY2013-14.

10 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$3,043,791 from
11 the General Fund and \$246,794 from federal funds for FY2012-13 and
12 (2) \$3,043,791 from the General Fund and \$246,794 from federal funds
13 for FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
14 Program 347, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
15 Bill 820, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

16 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
17 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
18 in this section.

19 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$2,400 from the
20 General Fund for FY2012-13 and (2) \$2,400 from the General Fund for
21 FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program
22 353, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 820,
23 One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

24 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
25 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated

1 in this section.

2 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect

3 when passed and approved according to law.
