LEGISLATIVE BILL 891A

Introduced by Nordquist, 7.

Read first time March 28, 2012

A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend Laws 2011, LB374,
2 section 108; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out
3 the provisions of Legislative Bill 891, One Hundred
4 Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012; to repeal the
5 original section; and to declare an emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$21,239 from
 2 the General Fund and \$101,239 from federal funds for FY2012-13 and
 3 (2) \$11,239 from the General Fund and \$11,239 from federal funds for
 4 FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program
 5 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 891,
 6 One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

7 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
 8 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
 9 exceed \$15,341 for FY2012-13 or \$15,341 for FY2013-14.

10 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$401,363 from
 11 the General Fund and \$510,411 from federal funds for FY2012-13 and
 12 (2) \$411,363 from the General Fund and \$523,128 from federal funds
 13 for FY2013-14 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
 14 Program 348, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative
 15 Bill 891, One Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.

16 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and
 17 per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated
 18 in this section.

 7 for FY2011-12 \$4,790,612 General Funds, \$11,295,817 Cash Funds, and
 8 \$45,576,830 Federal Funds estimate for state aid, which shall only be
 9 used for such purpose. There is included in the appropriation to this
 10 program for FY2012-13 ~~\$4,790,612~~—\$4,368,010 General Funds,
 11 \$11,295,817 Cash Funds, and \$45,848,225 Federal Funds estimate for
 12 state aid, which shall only be used for such purpose.

13 There is included in the appropriation to this program
 14 \$653,759 General Funds for FY2011-12 and \$653,759 General Funds for
 15 FY2012-13, which shall only be used for the following purposes:
 16 Reimbursement for the provision of pap smears, colposcopy, cervical
 17 biopsy, cryotherapy, loop electrosurgical excision procedure (LEEP),
 18 and such other treatments and procedures as may be developed for the
 19 followup of abnormal pap smears; the diagnosis and treatment of
 20 sexually transmitted diseases, including, but not limited to,
 21 chlamydia, gonorrhoea, HPV (genital warts), and herpes; and associated
 22 laboratory and equipment costs and staff training costs relating to
 23 the use of colposcopy equipment. None of the General Funds provided
 24 under this program shall be used to perform or facilitate the

1 performance of abortion or to counsel or refer for abortion.

2 Sec. 4. Original Laws 2011, LB374, section 108, is
3 repealed.

4 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
5 when passed and approved according to law.
