LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 479

Introduced by Haar, 21.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to study Nebraska's laws and regulations on radon gas exposure, particularly the effect of radon gas on Nebraska's children. The study should review the laws and regulations in place to protect children from harmful exposure in child care centers and similar places that children spend their time. The study should include a review of the issues raised during the consideration of LB 945 (Haar), which was introduced in 2012 and referred to the Health and Human Services Committee. In order to carry out the purpose of this resolution, the committee should seek out the advice of the Nebraska Radon Program administered by the Department of Health and Human Services and licensed child care providers and the committee should consider the input of interested persons as the committee deems necessary and beneficial.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
