The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 163 attempts to bring efficiency and streamline the process of issuing and accessing handicapped parking permits and tags. Specifically, the bill:

- extends the renewal period for permanent issue permits from three to six years;
- computerizes the application process to make it easier for applying and verification of medical certification;
- authorizes two handicapped permits to be issued to a person for convenience; and
- allows for two replacement tags in a six year period before requiring a new medical certification.
