1 1. Strike the original sections and insert the following
2 new sections:

3 Section 1. Section 83-1217.01, Reissue Revised Statutes
4 of Nebraska, is amended to read:

5 83-1217.01 ~~Employees~~ (1) Each employee of state-operated
6 services and facilities providing developmental disabilities
7 services shall be subject to the criminal history record
8 information check requirements of subdivision (9) of section
9 83-1217 and section 83-1217.02. shall file a complete set of his
10 or her legible fingerprints with the department. The department
11 shall transmit such fingerprints to the Nebraska State Patrol
12 which shall transmit a copy of the applicant's fingerprints to the
13 Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for
14 a national criminal history record information check.

15 (2) The national criminal history record information
16 check shall include information concerning the employee from
17 federal repositories of such information and repositories of such
18 information in other states if authorized by federal law for use by
19 the department.

20 (3) The Nebraska State Patrol shall undertake a search
21 for Nebraska criminal history record information concerning the
22 employee. The Nebraska State Patrol shall issue a report to the
23 department which contains the results of the criminal history

1 record information check conducted by the Nebraska State Patrol.

2 (4) Criminal history record information subject to
3 federal confidentiality requirements shall remain confidential
4 and may be released only upon the written authorization of the
5 employee.

6 (5) The department, in cooperation with the Nebraska
7 State Patrol, shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
8 carry out this section.

9 Sec. 2. Original section 83-1217.01, Reissue Revised
10 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
