LB306 amends the Judges' Retirement Act as follows.

- Eliminates the July 1, 2014 sunset on the \$6 court fees. Current law provides for a return to \$5 court fees on July 1, 2014. The
 FY2014-15 cost avoidance to the State by eliminating the sunset is estimated by the Nebraska Public Employees Retirement
 System (NPERS) at \$556,156.
- 2. Eliminates the July 1, 2014 sunset on the additional 1% member contribution rate. The FY2014-15 cost avoidance to the State by eliminating the sunset is estimated at \$193,000.
