A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to state aircraft; to amend section 3-106,

Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to direct the

purchase and sale of certain aircraft for state

government; to provide for operation, maintenance, and

hangaring; to repeal the original section; and to declare

an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. The Executive Board of the Legislative Council 2 pursuant to the authority granted in Laws 2012, LB194, section 9, 3 commissioned an independent study to enable the Legislature to 4 determine whether the state should purchase an aircraft for state purposes and what type of aircraft should be purchased, if any. After 5 6 completion and review of the study, the Legislature authorizes the 7 Department of Aeronautics to purchase a new aircraft. It is the 8 intent of the Legislature to fund the purchase with General Funds and 9 other funds. The Legislature also directs the department to sell the 10 state's 1982 Piper Cheyenne aircraft, with the proceeds retained by the department for use for preventive maintenance funding for the new 11 12 <u>aircraft.</u> 13 Sec. 2. The Nebraska Emergency Management Agency shall 14 operate, maintain, and hangar the state aircraft purchased by the 15 Department of Aeronautics pursuant to section 1 of this act pursuant 16 to an agreement between the agency and department. The state aircraft shall be subject at all times to the written orders of the Governor 17 for use and service in any branch of the state government. 18 Sec. 3. Section 3-106, Reissue Revised Statutes of 19 20 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3-106 (1) Suitable offices shall be provided for the 21 22 department in the State Capitol. It may maintain offices at such other places in the state as it may designate and may incur the 23 necessary expense for office furniture, stationery, printing, and 24 25 other incidental or necessary expenses for the enforcement of

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1 sections 3-101 to 3-154—the State Aeronautics Department Act and the

- 2 general promotion of aeronautics within the state.
- 3 (2) The department may purchase aircraft for the use of
- 4 the department. Such state government and may sell any state aircraft
- 5 that is not needed or suitable for state uses. State aircraft shall
- 6 be subject at all times to the written orders of the Governor for use
- 7 and service in any branch of the state government. The state aircraft
- 8 purchased pursuant to section 1 of this act shall be maintained,
- 9 operated, and hangared by the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency
- 10 pursuant to an agreement between the department and agency. The
- 11 <u>department shall establish an hourly rate for use of a state aircraft</u>
- 12 by a state official or agency. The hourly rate shall not include an
- 13 amount to recover the initial cost of the state aircraft, but shall
- 14 include amounts for items such as variable fuel and oil costs,
- 15 routine maintenance costs, landing fees, and preventive maintenance
- 16 <u>reserves.</u> with the expense thereof to be paid by the department. It
- 17 <u>(3) The department may employ such clerical and other</u>
- 18 employees and assistants as it may deem necessary for the proper
- 19 transaction of its business.
- 20 Sec. 4. Original section 3-106, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 21 of Nebraska, is repealed.
- 22 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 23 when passed and approved according to law.
