A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to elections; to amend section 32-944, Reissue  
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions and  
3 require reports regarding administration of ballots to  
4 residents of nursing homes or hospitals; and to repeal  
5 the original section.  
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 32-944, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   32-944 The election commissioner or county clerk may  
4 train registered voters to act on behalf of the election commissioner  
5 or county clerk in administering a ballot to residents of nursing  
6 homes or hospitals who have requested ballots. Ballots shall be  
7 administered by two registered voters who are not affiliated with the  
8 same political party. The election commissioner or county clerk shall  
9 adopt procedures to carry out this section and shall include the  
10 procedures in the written plan submitted to the Secretary of State  
11 pursuant to subdivision (9) of section 32-1049. Within sixty days  
12 after any statewide primary, general, or special election, the  
13 election commissioner or county clerk shall submit a report to the  
14 Secretary of State indicating the number of ballots cast pursuant to  
15 this section, the name and party affiliation of each registered voter  
16 administering such ballots, the name and address of each nursing home  
17 or hospital where such ballots were administered, and any other  
18 information requested by the Secretary of State regarding the  
19 distribution of ballots at nursing homes or hospitals pursuant to  
20 this section.

21                   Sec. 2. Original section 32-944, Reissue Revised Statutes  
22 of Nebraska, is repealed.
