A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act; to
2 amend section 60-174, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3 Nebraska, and sections 60-101 and 60-102, Revised
4 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to define a term;
5 to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
6 sections.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

3 60-101 Sections 60-101 to 60-197 and section 3 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Certificate
5 of Title Act.

6 Sec. 2. Section 60-102, Revised Statutes Cumulative
7 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:

8 60-102 For purposes of the Motor Vehicle Certificate of
9 Title Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the definitions
10 found in sections 60-103 to 60-136.01 and section 3 of this act shall
11 be used.

12 Sec. 3. Flood damage means water damage to a vehicle
13 which has been submerged above its floorboard.

14 Sec. 4. Section 60-174, Reissue Revised Statutes of
15 Nebraska, is amended to read:

16 60-174 Whenever a title is issued in this state for a
17 vehicle that is designated a salvage, previously salvaged, ~~or~~
18 manufacturer buyback, or flood damaged, the following title brands
19 shall be required: Salvage, previously salvaged, ~~or~~—manufacturer
20 buyback, or flood damaged. A certificate branded salvage, previously
21 salvaged, ~~or~~—manufacturer buyback, or flood damaged shall be
22 administered in the same manner and for the same fee or fees as
23 provided for a certificate of title in sections 60-154 to 60-160.
24 When a salvage branded certificate of title is surrendered for a
25 certificate of title branded previously salvaged, the application for

1 a certificate of title shall be accompanied by a statement of
2 inspection as provided in section 60-146.

4 of Nebraska, and sections 60-101 and 60-102, Revised Statutes
5 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
