A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to insurance consultants; to amend section
- 2 44-2629, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to permit
- 3 collection of fees as prescribed; to repeal the original
- 4 section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 44-2629, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 44-2629 (1) A consultant is obligated, under his or her
4 license, to serve with objectivity and complete loyalty the interests
5 of his or her client and to render his or her client such
6 information, counsel, and service as within the knowledge,
7 understanding, and opinion, in good faith of the licensee, best
8 serves the client's insurance needs and interest.

9 (2) Nothing in this section or any other Nebraska
10 statutes shall be construed as prohibiting or restricting the right
11 of a client having one hundred or more average total employees during
12 the calendar year preceding the year in which the request is made to
13 request that a third party, including an insurance company issuing a
14 policy to the client, collect from the client and remit to the
15 consultant the fees charged by the consultant for services allowed by
16 sections 44-2606 to 44-2635.

17 Sec. 2. Original section 44-2629, Reissue Revised
18 Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

19 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
20 when passed and approved according to law.
