A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act; to
2	amend section 60-494, Reissue Revised Statutes of
3	Nebraska, and section 60-484, Revised Statutes
4	Supplement, 2013; to change provisions relating to
5	applications and anatomical gifts; to eliminate obsolete
6	provisions; to harmonize provisions; to provide an
7	operative date; and to repeal the original sections.
8	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. Section 60-484, Revised Statutes Supplement,
2	2013, is amended to read:
3	60-484 (1)(a) This subsection applies until the
4	implementation date designated by the director on or before January
5	1, 2014. Except as otherwise provided in the Motor Vehicle Operator's
6	License Act, no resident of the State of Nebraska shall operate a
7	motor vehicle upon the alleys or highways of this state until the
8	person has obtained an operator's license for that purpose.
9	(b) Application for an operator's license or a state
10	identification card shall be made in a manner prescribed by the
11	department. Such application may be made to department personnel in
12	any county. Department personnel shall conduct the examination of the
13	applicant and deliver to each successful applicant an issuance
14	certificate containing the statements made pursuant to subdivision
15	(c) of this subsection.
16	(c) The applicant (i) shall provide his or her full legal
17	name, date of birth, mailing address, gender, race or ethnicity, and
18	social security number, two forms of proof of address of his or her
19	principal residence unless the applicant is a program participant
20	under the Address Confidentiality Act, evidence of identity as
21	required by subdivision (1)(f) of this subsection, and a brief
22	physical description of himself or herself, (ii) may complete the
23	voter registration portion pursuant to section 32-308, (iii) shall be
24	provided the advisement language required by subsection (5) of
25	section 60-6,197, (iv) shall answer the following:

20	only (i) to furnish information to the United States Selective
21	Service System under section 60-483, (ii) with the permission of the
22	director in connection with the verification of the status of an
23	individual's driving record in this state or any other state, (iii)
24	for purposes of child support enforcement pursuant to section
25	42-358.08 or 43-512.06, (iv) to furnish information regarding an

1 applicant for or holder of a commercial driver's license with a
2 hazardous materials endorsement to the Transportation Security
3 Administration of the United States Department of Homeland Security
4 or its agent, or (v) to furnish information to the Department of
5 Revenue under section 77-362.02.

6 (f)(i) Each individual applying for an operator's license 7 or a state identification card shall furnish proof of date of birth 8 and identity with documents containing a photograph or with nonphoto 9 identity documents which include his or her full legal name and date 10 of birth. Such documents shall include, but not be limited to, any 11 valid Nebraska operator's license or Nebraska state identification 12 card, a valid operator's license or identification card from another 13 state or jurisdiction of the United States, a certified birth 14 certificate, a valid United States passport, or any other United 15 States based identification as approved by the director.

16 (ii) Any individual under the age of eighteen years 17 applying for an operator's license or a state identification card 18 shall provide a certified copy of his or her birth certificate or, if 19 such individual is unable to provide a certified copy of his or her 20 birth certificate, other reliable proof of his or her identity and 21 age, as required in subdivision (1)(f)(i) of this section, 22 accompanied by a certification signed by a parent or guardian 23 explaining the inability to produce a copy of such birth certificate. 24 The applicant also may be required to furnish proof to department 25 personnel that the parent or guardian signing the certification is in 1 fact the parent or guardian of such applicant.

2 (iii) An applicant may present other documents as proof 3 of identification and age designated by the director. Any documents 4 accepted shall be recorded according to a written exceptions process 5 established by the director.

6 (g) Any individual applying for an operator's license or 7 a state identification card who indicated his or her wish to have the 8 word "veteran" displayed on the front of such license or card shall 9 comply with section 60-4,189.

10 (2)(a) This subsection applies beginning on an 11 implementation date designated by the director on or before January 12 1, 2014. (1) Except as otherwise provided in the Motor Vehicle 13 Operator's License Act, no resident of the State of Nebraska shall 14 operate a motor vehicle upon the alleys or highways of this state 15 until the person has obtained an operator's license for that purpose.

16 (b) (2) Application for an operator's license or a state 17 identification card shall be made in a manner prescribed by the 18 department. Such application may be made to department personnel in 19 any county. Department personnel shall conduct the examination of the 20 applicant and deliver to each successful applicant an issuance 21 certificate containing the statements made pursuant to subdivision 22 (c) of this subsection (3) of this section.

23 (c) (3) The applicant shall provide his or her full legal 24 name, date of birth, mailing address, gender, race or ethnicity, and 25 social security number, two forms of proof of address of his or her

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identification card shall include a signed oath, affirmation, or
 declaration of the applicant that the information provided on the
 application for the license or card is true and correct.

(e) (5) The social security number shall not be printed 4 5 on the operator's license or state identification card and shall be used only (i) (a) to furnish information to the United States 6 7 Selective Service System under section 60-483, (ii) (b) with the 8 permission of the director in connection with the verification of the status of an individual's driving record in this state or any other 9 state, (iii) (c) for purposes of child support enforcement pursuant 10 to section 42-358.08 or 43-512.06, (iv) (d) to furnish information 11 12 regarding an applicant for or holder of a commercial driver's license 13 with a hazardous materials endorsement to the Transportation Security 14 Administration of the United States Department of Homeland Security 15 or its agent, or $\frac{(v)}{(e)}$ to furnish information to the Department of 16 Revenue under section 77-362.02.

17 (f)(i)-(6)(a) Each individual applying for an operator's 18 license or a state identification card shall furnish proof of date of 19 birth and identity with documents containing a photograph or with 20 nonphoto identity documents which include his or her full legal name 21 and date of birth. Such documents shall be those provided in 22 subsection (2) of section 60-484.04.

23 (ii) (b) Any individual under the age of eighteen years 24 applying for an operator's license or a state identification card 25 shall provide a certified copy of his or her birth certificate or, if

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such individual is unable to provide a certified copy of his or her 1 2 birth certificate, other reliable proof of his or her identity and 3 age, as required in subdivision $\frac{(2)(f)(i)}{(6)(a)}$ of this section, 4 accompanied by a certification signed by a parent or guardian 5 explaining the inability to produce a copy of such birth certificate. The applicant also may be required to furnish proof to department б 7 personnel that the parent or guardian signing the certification is in 8 fact the parent or guardian of such applicant.

9 (iii) (c) An applicant may present other documents as 10 proof of identification and age designated by the director. Any 11 documents accepted shall be recorded according to a written 12 exceptions process established by the director.

13 (g) (7) Any individual applying for an operator's license 14 or a state identification card who indicated his or her wish to have 15 the word "veteran" displayed on the front of such license or card 16 shall comply with section 60-4,189.

17 (h) (8) No person shall be a holder of an operator's
 18 license and a state identification card at the same time.

19 Sec. 2. Section 60-494, Reissue Revised Statutes of 20 Nebraska, is amended to read:

21 60-494 (1) Each operator's license and state 22 identification card shall include a special notation on the front of 23 the license or card if the licensee or cardholder is at least sixteen 24 years of age and indicates on the application or examiner's issuance certificate under section 60-484, 60-4,144, or 60-4,181 his or her 25

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1 wish to be an organ donor, a tissue donor, or both.

2 (2) The status as an organ donor, a tissue donor, or both 3 shall be renewed upon renewal of each license or card if the licensee 4 or cardholder, at the time of renewal, indicates the desire to renew 5 the status and the notation authorized in subsection (1) of this section has been marked. continue until amended or revoked by the 6 7 licensee or cardholder as provided in section 71-4829. The status as 8 an organ donor, a tissue donor, or both is not changed by the expiration, suspension, cancellation, revocation, or impoundment of 9 10 the license or card.

11 (3) Any person whose operator's license or state 12 identification card indicates his or her status as an organ donor, a 13 tissue donor, or both may obtain a replacement license or card 14 without a notation of such status. The fee for such replacement 15 license or card shall be the fee provided in section 60-4,115.

16 (4) A licensee or cardholder may also change his or her
17 status as a donor by (a) Internet access to the Donor Registry of
18 Nebraska, (b) telephone request to the registry, or (c) other methods
19 approved by the federally designated organ procurement organization
20 for Nebraska.

(5) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall electronically transfer to the federally designated organ procurement organization for Nebraska all information which appears on the face of an original or replacement operator's license or state identification card except the image and signature of each person whose license or card includes

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1 the notation described in subsection (1) of this section.

Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2015.
Sec. 4. Original section 60-494, Reissue Revised Statutes
of Nebraska, and section 60-484, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2013,
are repealed.
