- FOR AN ACT relating to county veterans service offices; to amend section 80-410, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012; to change qualifications for county veterans service officers; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.

1 Section 1. Section 80-410, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 80-410 (1) The Director of Veterans' Affairs, all members
- 4 of the Veterans' Advisory Commission, all state service officers, all
- 5 assistant state service officers, and all personnel, except certain
- 6 special and clerical help, of the state veterans service offices
- 7 shall have served in the armed forces of the United States during the
- 8 dates set forth in section 80-401.01, shall have been discharged or
- 9 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable from such
- 10 service, and shall have been bona fide residents of the State of
- 11 Nebraska continuously for at least five years immediately prior to
- 12 their assuming a position in any of the offices mentioned.
- 13 (2) All county veterans service officers shall have
- 14 served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States, other
- 15 than active duty for training, shall have been discharged or
- 16 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable from the
- 17 service, and shall have been be bona fide residents of the State of
- 18 Nebraska continuously for at least five years immediately prior to
- 19 assuming any such position.
- 20 (3) All members of the county veterans service committees
- 21 and all personnel, except certain special and clerical help, of the
- 22 county veterans service offices shall have all of the qualifications
- 23 described in subsection (2) of this section, except that such persons
- 24 may have been discharged or otherwise separated with a
- 25 characterization of general (under honorable conditions).
