

AMENDMENTS TO LB1067

Introduced by Sullivan, 41.

1           1. Insert the following new section:

2           Sec. 32. Section 79-1007.06, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is  
3 amended to read:

4           79-1007.06 (1) ~~The For school fiscal year 2008-09 and each school~~  
5 ~~fiscal year thereafter,~~ the department shall determine the poverty  
6 allowance for each school district that meets the requirements of this  
7 section and section 79-1007.07. Each school district shall designate a  
8 maximum poverty allowance on a form prescribed by the department on or  
9 before October 15 of the school fiscal year immediately preceding the  
10 school fiscal year for which aid is being calculated. The school district  
11 may decline to participate in the poverty allowance by providing the  
12 department with a maximum poverty allowance of zero dollars on such form  
13 on or before October 15 of the school fiscal year immediately preceding  
14 the school fiscal year for which aid is being calculated. Each school  
15 district designating a maximum poverty allowance greater than zero  
16 dollars shall submit a poverty plan pursuant to section 79-1013.

17           (2) For school fiscal years prior to school fiscal year 2019-20, the  
18 ~~The~~ poverty allowance for each school district shall equal the lesser of:

19           (a) The maximum amount designated pursuant to subsection (1) of this  
20 section by the school district in the local system, if such school  
21 district designated a maximum amount, for the school fiscal year for  
22 which aid is being calculated; or

23           (b) The sum of:

24           (i) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
25 formula student multiplied by 0.0375 then multiplied by the poverty  
26 students comprising more than five percent and not more than ten percent  
27 of the formula students in the school district; plus

1 (ii) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
2 formula student multiplied by 0.0750 then multiplied by the poverty  
3 students comprising more than ten percent and not more than fifteen  
4 percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

5 (iii) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
6 formula student multiplied by 0.1125 then multiplied by the poverty  
7 students comprising more than fifteen percent and not more than twenty  
8 percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

9 (iv) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
10 formula student multiplied by 0.1500 then multiplied by the poverty  
11 students comprising more than twenty percent and not more than twenty-  
12 five percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

13 (v) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
14 formula student multiplied by 0.1875 then multiplied by the poverty  
15 students comprising more than twenty-five percent and not more than  
16 thirty percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

17 (vi) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
18 formula student multiplied by 0.2250 then multiplied by the poverty  
19 students comprising more than thirty percent of the formula students in  
20 the school district.

21 (3) For school fiscal year 2019-20 and each school fiscal year  
22 thereafter, the poverty allowance for each school district shall equal  
23 the lesser of:

24 (a) The maximum amount designated pursuant to subsection (1) of this  
25 section by the school district in the local system, if such school  
26 district designated a maximum amount, for the school fiscal year for  
27 which aid is being calculated; or

28 (b) The sum of:

29 (i) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
30 formula student multiplied by 0.0375 then multiplied by the poverty  
31 students comprising more than five percent and not more than ten percent

1 of the formula students in the school district; plus

2 (ii) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
3 formula student multiplied by 0.0750 then multiplied by the poverty  
4 students comprising more than ten percent and not more than fifteen  
5 percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

6 (iii) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
7 formula student multiplied by 0.1125 then multiplied by the poverty  
8 students comprising more than fifteen percent and not more than twenty  
9 percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

10 (iv) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
11 formula student multiplied by 0.1500 then multiplied by the poverty  
12 students comprising more than twenty percent and not more than twenty-  
13 five percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

14 (v) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
15 formula student multiplied by 0.1875 then multiplied by the poverty  
16 students comprising more than twenty-five percent and not more than  
17 thirty percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

18 (vi) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
19 formula student multiplied by 0.2250 then multiplied by the poverty  
20 students comprising more than thirty percent and not more than forty  
21 percent of the formula students in the school district; plus

22 (vii) The statewide average general fund operating expenditures per  
23 formula student multiplied by 0.2450 then multiplied by the poverty  
24 students comprising more than forty percent of the formula students in  
25 the school district.

26 (4) For school fiscal year 2017-18, each school district with  
27 poverty students comprising more than forty percent of the formula  
28 students in the school district shall have a poverty allowance adjustment  
29 calculated equal to the statewide average general fund operating  
30 expenditures per formula student multiplied by 0.0125 then multiplied by  
31 the difference of the poverty students minus forty percent of the formula

1 students for such school district.

2 (5) For school fiscal year 2018-19, each school district with  
3 poverty students comprising more than forty percent of the formula  
4 students in the school district shall have a poverty allowance adjustment  
5 calculated equal to the statewide average general fund operating  
6 expenditures per formula student multiplied by 0.0200 then multiplied by  
7 the difference of the poverty students minus forty percent of the formula  
8 students for such school district.

9 2. On page 60, line 19, strike "five" and insert "two"; and in line  
10 20 after "79-1007.06" insert "plus two percent of the limited English  
11 proficiency allowance calculated pursuant to section 79-1007.08".

12 3. On page 62, line 16, after "allowance," insert "poverty allowance  
13 adjustment,".

14 4. On page 71, line 8, strike "2019-20" and insert "2018-19"; in  
15 lines 15 and 19 before "district" insert "individual"; in lines 26 and 27  
16 strike "local" through "79-1015.01" and insert "allocated income tax  
17 funds calculated pursuant to section 79-1005.01"; in line 29 after  
18 "total" insert "equalization plus allocated income taxes"; and in line 30  
19 after "total" insert "equalization plus allocated income taxes".

20 5. On page 72, line 1, after "total" insert "equalization plus  
21 allocated income taxes"; in line 2 after "(e)" insert "Dividing the  
22 difference of the formula need for the individual member district minus  
23 the share of the aggregate total equalization plus allocated income taxes  
24 minus the individual member district net option funding by the difference  
25 of the aggregate total formula need for all member school districts minus  
26 the aggregate total equalization plus allocated income taxes minus the  
27 aggregate total net option funding for all member school districts to  
28 determine the member school district share of unmet formula need;

29 (f) Multiplying the aggregate yield from local effort rate for all  
30 member school districts by the member school district share of unmet  
31 formula need to determine the member school district share of common levy

1 yield from local effort rate;

2 (g) Adding the member school district share of the aggregate total  
3 equalization plus allocated income taxes to the member school district  
4 share of the common levy yield from local effort rate to determine the  
5 individual common levy total for the member school district;

6 (h)" and before "equalization" insert "individual"; in line 3 strike  
7 "for the member school district" and insert "and allocated income tax  
8 funds calculated pursuant to section 79-1005.01"; in line 5 before  
9 "comparison" insert "individual"; in line 6 strike "(f)" and insert  
10 "(i)", before "comparison" insert "individual", and before "member"  
11 insert "individual common levy total for"; in line 7 strike "share of the  
12 aggregate total"; in line 10 strike "(g)" and insert "(j)"; in lines 10  
13 and 11 strike "seventy-five" through "2017-18,"; in line 12 strike  
14 "2018-19," and insert "2017-18" and strike "2019-20" and insert  
15 "2018-19".

16 6. Renumber the remaining sections and correct the repealer  
17 accordingly.
