Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would amend section 44-4054 of the Insurance Producers Licensing Act to provide that an insurance producer may receive qualification for a license in a new line of authority: "limited line pre-need funeral insurance." (Section 4)

The bill would amend section 44-4049 of the Insurance Producers Licensing Act to define "limited line pre-need funeral insurance" as life insurance or a fixed annuity contract to pay the costs of funeral services or funeral service merchandise to be purchased from a funeral home or cemetery. (Section 3)

The bill would amend section 44-3909 to provide that an individual seeking a license to sell limited line pre-need funeral insurance shall complete three hours of prelicensing education on insurance industry ethics in addition to three hours in the area of life insurance if such individual holds a state license as a funeral director and embalmer or five hours in the area of life insurance if such individual does not hold a state license as a funeral director and embalmer. (Section 2)

The bill would amend section 44-3904 to provide that a licensee qualified to solicit only limited line pre-need funeral insurance shall complete three hours of continuing education activities in each two-year period if such licensee holds a state license as a funeral director and embalmer or six hours of continuing education activities in each two-year period if such licensee does not hold a state license as a funeral director and embalmer. (Section 1)
