Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would amend section 76-550 of the Abstracters Act to eliminate a requirement that a roster showing the names and places of business of abstracters holding an operative certificate of registration shall be prepared by the director of the Abstracters Board of Examiners each even-numbered year, sent to all registered abstracters, and furnished to the public on request at cost.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendments would reinstate the requirement that the Abstracters Board of Examiners shall prepare a roster of registered abstracters and then would insert a new requirement that the roster shall be maintained and updated at least annually on the board's web site in a printable form. The committee amendments would make no change in underlying bill's elimination of requirements for distribution of hard copies of the roster.
