Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB30 would create a new section to prohibit the disclosure of certain information regarding firearms registration, possession, sale, or use.

The bill provides that any information regarding firearm registration, possession, sale, or use is confidential and shall not be considered a public record within the meaning of sections 84-712 to 84-712.09.

This section would govern information obtained by the Nebraska State Patrol or any other federal, state, county, or local "department or agency", and would apply whether the information was obtained for purposes of application or issued as a permit or license.

The bill also states that the information shall be available upon request for "specific investigatory purposes" to all federal, state, county, and local law enforcement agencies.

Explanation of amendments:

AM29 to LB30 would strike "for specific investigatory purposes" from page 2, line 7. As amended, information regarding firearm registration, possession, sale, or use would continue to be available to all federal, state, county, and local law enforcement agencies.
