Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Legislative Bill 683 amends section 77-3506, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement 2014; and section 77-3509, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to change provisions relating to homestead exemptions for certain surviving spouses.

The amendments in LB683 would harmonize Nebraska statute with federal law, regarding surviving spouses of veterans and the furnishing of benefits relating to dependency and indemnity of compensation, allowing a surviving spouse who remarries after the age of fifty-seven to retain their current homestead exemption status.
