LB 163 requires the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency to provide or contract for an emergency management registry. A secure web-site will be used to collect information from individuals to be used in emergency situations and planning. Information collected can include physical descriptions, medical conditions and allergies, household information, primary language, and emergency contacts. At least twice a year each individual will be requested to update their information. The public provided information will automatically display to persons authorized to answer 911 emergency calls. The registry will also allow law enforcement personnel to search for emergency contacts in the event of a motor vehicle accident or other emergency.

The bill expresses legislative intent to appropriate \$900,000 of General Funds in FY2015-16, and \$600,000 of General Funds in FY2016-17, to fund the emergency management registry.
