Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 176 would amend provisions of the Competitive Livestock Market Act. It is estimated that revised definitions about contract swine operations in the state would have no fiscal impact upon the Department of Agriculture. LB 176 also states that a purpose of the Competitive Livestock Markets act is to provide for the continuation of livestock market mandatory price reporting in the event that federal mandatory reporting provisions are terminated. There would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Agriculture unless the federal act would expire, whereupon it is estimated that the agency would require additional appropriations to administer the reporting program
