**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

This bill would prohibit certain regulation of firearms, ammunition, and firearm accessories by cities and villages as prescribed.

The bill allows a person adversely impacted by a city or village ordinance to recover damages, court costs, and attorney fees. This could have a fiscal impact to cities or villages, both in paying to defend any such lawsuit, or in paying any of the above-noted costs if a city or village lost or settled the lawsuit. At this time, the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) does not have any information in which to prepare an estimate of any potential costs to cities or villages. If the LFO receives any information from the cities to which this bill was sent, this fiscal note will be updated.
