Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 973 would require the permits issued by the Department of Roads for moving buildings or objects requiring specialized moving dollies to clearly state that the applicant is not authorized to manipulate overhead high voltage lines or other such components, and that the applicant is guilty of a class II misdemeanor for violations. The bill also requires a person to carry proof that they have notified the local authority and the electric utility responsible for poles, wires, etc. prior to moving a building. Penalties for violations of related provisions are stated.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 973 changes provisions involving permits issued relating to moving certain buildings on a road or highway where high voltage lines are involved. Section 60-6,299 has been revised to add that such permits shall clearly state that the applicant is not authorized to manipulate overhead high voltage lines, conductors and other such components to include electric utility poles. If a violation occurs that applicant shall be guilty of a Class II misdemeanor. This bill also adds in Section 60-6,288, that any person moving a building or an object as described in this section, must have proof of the notification required under subsection (1) of this section. Any person who fails to comply with the notification requirements shall be guilty of a Class II misdemeanor.

No fiscal impact is anticipated for the Department.
