1 Section 1. Section 60-6,197.06, Reissue Revised Statutes of

2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

- 60-6,197.06 (1) Unless otherwise provided by law pursuant to an 3 4 ignition interlock permit, any person operating a motor vehicle on the 5 highways or streets of this state while his or her operator's license has been revoked pursuant to section 28-306, section 60-698, subdivision (4), 6 7 (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), or (10) of section 60-6,197.03, or section 60-6,198, or pursuant to subdivision (2)(c) or (2)(d) of section 60-6,196 8 9 or subdivision (4)(c) or (4)(d) of section 60-6,197 as such subdivisions existed prior to July 16, 2004, shall be guilty of a Class IV felony, and 10 the court shall, as part of the judgment of conviction, revoke the 11 operator's license of such person for a period of fifteen years from the 12 date ordered by the court and shall issue an order pursuant to section 13 60-6,197.01. Such revocation and order shall be administered upon 14 sentencing, upon final judgment of any appeal or review, or upon the date 15 that any probation is revoked. 16
- (2) If such person has had a conviction under this section or under 17 subsection (6) of section 60-6,196 or subsection (7) of section 60-6,197, 18 as such subsections existed prior to July 16, 2004, <u>and operates a motor</u> 19 vehicle on the highways or streets of this state while his or her 20 operator's license has been revoked pursuant to such conviction prior to 21 22 the date of the current conviction under this section, such person shall be guilty of a Class III felony, and the court shall, as part of the 23 24 judgment of conviction, revoke the operator's license of such person for 25 an additional a period of fifteen years from the date ordered by the court and shall issue an order pursuant to section 60-6,197.01. Such 26 revocation and order shall be administered upon sentencing, upon final 27 28 judgment of any appeal or review, or upon the date that any probation is revoked. 29
