## LEGISLATIVE BILL 508

Committee: Education
A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to teachers; to provide minimum requirements for acceptance to teacher education programs as prescribed; and to provide for rules and regulations.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,
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Section 1. In order to be approved by the State Board of Education through the Commissioner of Education pursuant to section 79-318 on and after January 1, 2019, a teacher education program shall have the following minimum entry requirements for applicants:
(1) A grade-point average of not less than 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or a grade-point average in the top fiftieth percentile for coursework completed during the most recent two years of the applicant's education, whether secondary or postsecondary; and
(2) Demonstrated mastery of general knowledge, including the ability to read, write, and compute, by achieving a minimum score determined by the State Board of Education on a standardized test normed to the general college-bound population and approved by the state board, including, but not limited to, the Praxis Series tests administered by the Educational Testing Service, the SAT published by the College Board and administered by the Educational Testing Service, or the ACT college readiness assessment administered by $A C T$, or an equivalent test approved by the commissioner.

The state board may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out this section.
