

AMENDMENTS TO LB46

Introduced by Pansing Brooks, 28.

1           1. Insert the following new sections:

2           Sec. 10. (1) The department shall design license plates to be known  
3 as End Rape Culture License Plates. The department shall create designs  
4 reflecting support for ending rape culture and supporting the victims of  
5 rape in Nebraska. The design shall be selected on the basis of limiting  
6 the manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than or equal to  
7 the amount charged for license plates pursuant to section 60-3,102. The  
8 department shall make applications available for this type of plate  
9 beginning January 1, 2018. The department may adopt and promulgate rules  
10 and regulations to carry out this section and section 11 of this act.

11           (2) One type of End Rape Culture License Plates shall be  
12 alphanumeric plates. The department shall:

13           (a) Assign a designation up to five characters; and

14           (b) Not use a county designation.

15           (3) One type of End Rape Culture License Plates shall be  
16 personalized message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject to the  
17 same conditions specified for personalized message license plates in  
18 section 60-3,118, except that a maximum of five characters may be used.

19           Sec. 11. (1) Beginning January 1, 2018, a person may apply to the  
20 department for End Rape Culture License Plates in lieu of regular license  
21 plates on an application prescribed and provided by the department for  
22 any motor vehicle or trailer, except for a motor vehicle or trailer  
23 registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant receiving an End Rape  
24 Culture License Plate for a farm truck with a gross weight of over  
25 sixteen tons or a commercial truck or truck-tractor with a gross weight  
26 of five tons or over shall affix the appropriate tonnage decal to the  
27 plate. The department shall make forms available for such applications

1 through the county treasurers. The license plates shall be issued upon  
2 payment of the license fee described in subsection (2) of this section.

3 (2)(a) In addition to all other fees required for registration under  
4 the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, each application for initial issuance  
5 of alphanumeric End Rape Culture License Plates shall be accompanied by a  
6 fee of five dollars. An application for renewal of such plates shall be  
7 accompanied by a fee of five dollars. County treasurers collecting fees  
8 pursuant to this subdivision shall remit them to the State Treasurer. The  
9 State Treasurer shall credit five dollars of the fee to the Nebraska  
10 Child Abuse Prevention Fund.

11 (b) In addition to all other fees required for registration under  
12 the Motor Vehicle Registration Act, each application for initial issuance  
13 or renewal of personalized message End Rape Culture License Plates shall  
14 be accompanied by a fee of forty dollars. County treasurers collecting  
15 fees pursuant to this subdivision shall remit them to the State  
16 Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit twenty-five percent of the  
17 fee for initial issuance and renewal of such plates to the Department of  
18 Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and seventy-five percent of the fee to the  
19 Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund.

20 (3) When the department receives an application for End Rape Culture  
21 License Plates, the department shall deliver the plates to the county  
22 treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle or trailer is  
23 registered. The county treasurer shall issue End Rape Culture License  
24 Plates in lieu of regular license plates when the applicant complies with  
25 the other provisions of the Motor Vehicle Registration Act for  
26 registration of the motor vehicle or trailer. If End Rape Culture License  
27 Plates are lost, stolen, or mutilated, the licensee shall be issued  
28 replacement license plates upon request pursuant to section 60-3,157.

29 (4) The owner of a motor vehicle or trailer bearing End Rape Culture  
30 License Plates may apply to the county treasurer to have such plates  
31 transferred to a motor vehicle other than the vehicle for which such

1 plates were originally purchased if such vehicle is owned by the owner of  
2 the plates. The owner may have the unused portion of the fee for the  
3 plates credited to the other vehicle which will bear the plates at the  
4 rate of eight and one-third percent per month for each full month left in  
5 the registration period. Application for such transfer shall be  
6 accompanied by a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this  
7 subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the  
8 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

9 (5) If the cost of manufacturing End Rape Culture License Plates at  
10 any time exceeds the amount charged for license plates pursuant to  
11 section 60-3,102, any money to be credited to the Nebraska Child Abuse  
12 Prevention Fund shall instead be credited first to the Highway Trust Fund  
13 in an amount equal to the difference between the manufacturing costs of  
14 End Rape Culture License Plates and the amount charged pursuant to  
15 section 60-3,102 with respect to such plates and the remainder shall be  
16 credited to the Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund.

17 2. On page 2, line 6, after the comma insert "the fees for End Rape  
18 Culture License Plates as provided in section 11 of this act,"; and in  
19 line 26 strike "and 9" and insert "to 11".

20 3. On page 3, lines 14 and 21; and page 6, line 2, strike "section  
21 9" and insert "sections 9 and 11".

22 4. On page 7, after line 14 insert the following new subdivision:  
23 "(11) End Rape Culture License Plates issued pursuant to sections 10  
24 and 11 of this act;"; and renumber the remaining subdivisions  
25 accordingly.

26 5. On page 11, line 2, before the comma insert ", End Rape Culture  
27 License Plates".

28 6. Renumber the remaining section accordingly.
