## **SELECT FILE: 2018 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS**

- LB 861 (*Watermeier*) Require certain prosecution costs be paid by the state and authorize independent counsel requests by the Attorney General for certain criminal cases
- LB 1081 (*Education Committee*) Change education provisions regarding reporting, penalties, residency, boundaries, priority schools, subpoena authority, poverty, and limited English proficiency and adopt the Nebraska Reading Improvement Act
- LB 1081A (*Groene*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 1089 (*Smith*) Change provisions relating to confidential tax information, refundable income tax credits, and homestead exemptions
- LB 994 (*Friesen*) Create the Rural Broadband Task Force and exempt dark fiber from sales tax
- LB 994A (*Friesen*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 731 (*Williams*) Change provisions relating to physical therapy, respiratory care, and the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act, provide for mobile salons and remote dispensing pharmacies, and adopt the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact
- LB 731A (*Williams*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 807 (*Harr*) Provide for replacement of statues in the United States Capitol
- LB 807A (*Harr*) Appropriation Bill
- LB 670 (*Krist*) Change provisions relating to the juvenile justice system
- LB 1120 (*Larson*) Change provisions of the Nebraska Liquor Control Act and music licensing provisions
- LB 873 (*Urban Affairs Committee*) Change provisions relating to cities of particular classes and villages, correct and include references as prescribed, eliminate obsolete provisions and repeal definitions, provide for interlocal nuisance agreements, to determine population thresholds, redefine certain economic development programs, authorize creation of additional land banks, change comprehensive plans for an early childhood element, authorize short-term rentals, and change provisions relating to the official state slogan and symbol
- LB 953 (*Albrecht*) Change provisions under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act and the Employee Classification Act
