Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 101 amends Sections 73-506 and 81-1118 to prevent state agencies and the state purchasing bureau from amending contracts to extend in duration for more than 50% of the initial contract term, and prevent more than one permissible contract duration amendment. It does not prohibit the exercise of a renewal option expressly provided for in the original contract.
