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Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1035 amends the Stroke System of Care Act to add "endovascular therapy capable stroke centers" to designations allowed by the Department of Health and Human Services.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 71-474 to add endovascular therapy capable stroke center to restrictions on advertising.

Section 2: Amends Section 71-4204 to add endovascular therapy capable stroke centers to the list of designations for the Department of Health and Human Services. Allows the Department of Health and Human Services to issue certification.

Section 3: Amends Section 71-4205 to add endovascular therapy capable stroke center to hospital designations for coordinating stroke agreements.

Section 4: Amends Section 71-4209 to add hospitals designated as endovascular therapy capable stroke centers to the stroke care task force.

Section 5: Repeals Sections 71-474, 71-4204, 71-4205, and 71-4209.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1741 strikes "endovascular therapy" and replaces with "designated thrombectomy." Strikes allowance of the Department of Health and Human Services to issue certification.
