LB 706 eliminates the six hundred credit requirement for licensure of an electrologist. Eliminates the definition "electrology establishment."

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 38-1062 to eliminate six hundred credits for licensure of an electrologist.

Section 2: Amends Section 38-1066 to eliminate the term electrology establishment.

Section 3: Repeals Sections 38-1062 and 38-1066.

Section 4: Repeals Section 38-1022.
