LB 78 would allow the negotiated settlement between the Nebraska Department of Transportation and a political subdivision in regards to abandonment and acceptance of a segment on the state highway system to be renegotiated if the political subdivision can show a change in financial or other circumstances or for economic development purposes. It would be up to the department whether to agree to the new terms or conditions.

LB 78 is authorizing legislation and as such will not have a direct fiscal impact. No fiscal impact will occur until such time that a political subdivision petitions the department to renegotiate the agreement and the department agrees to changes which have a fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB78 changes the provisions relating to relinquishment or abandonment of a highway fragment, section, or route.

After the filing of such petition, terms or conditions of any relinquishment, including any reservation of right by either party may be negotiated. A written memorandum of understanding executed by the department and the political or governmental subdivision will be required and shall be filed as a public record along with the petition and a written instrument describing the proposed relinquishment.

At any time after the relinquishment, the political or governmental subdivision or public corporation may petition to renegotiate the agreed terms or conditions of the relinquishments or revert to abandonment upon showing a change in financial or other circumstances or for economic development purposes. If new terms are agreed upon, an amended memorandum of understanding shall be executed, certified and record an amended written instrument with the register of deeds.

No fiscal impact is anticipated to the Department.
