**LEGISLATIVE BILL 376**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state property; to donate certain property
- 2 to the Northeast Community College Area as prescribed; and to
- 3 declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1.   (1) For purposes of this section, qualified property  
2 means the 43.55 acres that were deemed to be not needed for state  
3 purposes pursuant to section 90-202 and were deemed to be excess land by  
4 the Vacant Building and Excess Land Committee.

5           (2) Notwithstanding sections 72-811 to 72-818 or any other provision  
6 of law, the Director of Administrative Services shall, within thirty days  
7 after the effective date of this act, submit a request to the Legislature  
8 and the Governor asking for authorization to convey the qualified  
9 property to the Northeast Community College Area as a donation so that  
10 the qualified property may be used for the purpose of development of the  
11 Northeast Community College Technology Park.

12           (3) Approval of the Governor and the Legislature or, if the  
13 Legislature is not in session, the Executive Board of the Legislative  
14 Council shall be required to donate the qualified property to the  
15 Northeast Community College Area.

16           (4) If the Northeast Community College Area sells the qualified  
17 property within ten years after it is donated pursuant to this section,  
18 all proceeds of the sale shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for  
19 credit to the General Fund.

20           Sec. 2.   Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when  
21 passed and approved according to law.
