- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Election Act; to amend section 32-1535,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 32-947, Revised
- 3 Statutes Supplement, 2017; to provide requirements for returning a
- 4 ballot for early voting on behalf of someone else; to provide a
- 5 penalty; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 32-947, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 32-947 (1) Upon receipt of an application or other request for a
- 4 ballot to vote early, the election commissioner or county clerk shall
- 5 determine whether the applicant is a registered voter and is entitled to
- 6 vote as requested. If the election commissioner or county clerk
- 7 determines that the applicant is a registered voter entitled to vote
- 8 early and the application was received not later than the close of
- 9 business on the second Friday preceding the election, the election
- 10 commissioner or county clerk shall deliver a ballot to the applicant in
- 11 person or by mail, postage paid. The election commissioner or county
- 12 clerk or any employee of the election commissioner or county clerk shall
- 13 write or cause to be affixed his or her customary signature or initials
- 14 on the ballot.
- 15 (2) An unsealed identification envelope shall be delivered with the
- 16 ballot, and upon the back of the envelope shall be printed a form
- 17 substantially as follows:
- 18 VOTER'S OATH
- 19 I, the undersigned voter, declare that the enclosed ballot or
- 20 ballots contained no voting marks of any kind when I received them, and I
- 21 caused the ballot or ballots to be marked, enclosed in the identification
- 22 envelope, and sealed in such envelope.
- To the best of my knowledge and belief, I declare under penalty of
- 24 election falsification that:
- 25 (a) I,, am a registered voter
- 26 in County;
- 27 (b) I reside in the State of Nebraska at;
- 28 (c) I have voted the enclosed ballot and am returning it in
- 29 compliance with Nebraska law; and
- 30 (d) I have not voted and will not vote in this election except by
- 31 this ballot.

- 1 ANY PERSON WHO SIGNS THIS FORM KNOWING THAT ANY OF THE INFORMATION
- 2 IN THE FORM IS FALSE SHALL BE GUILTY OF ELECTION FALSIFICATION, A CLASS
- 3 IV FELONY UNDER SECTION 32-1502 OF THE STATUTES OF NEBRASKA. THE PENALTY
- 4 FOR ELECTION FALSIFICATION IS IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO TWO YEARS AND TWELVE
- 5 MONTHS POST-RELEASE SUPERVISION OR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TEN THOUSAND
- 6 DOLLARS, OR BOTH.
- 7 I also understand that failure to sign below will invalidate my
- 8 ballot.
- 9 Signature
- 10 (3)(a) (3) If the ballot and identification envelope will be
- 11 returned by mail or by someone other than the voter, the election
- 12 commissioner or county clerk shall include with the ballot:
- 13 <u>(i) A warning as follows: If you are returning this ballot for</u>
- 14 <u>someone else, you are subject to the penalties provided in section</u>
- 15 <u>32-1535</u> if you fail to return this ballot as required in this subsection;
- 16 and
- 17 (ii) An an identification envelope upon the face of which shall be
- 18 printed the official title and post office address of the election
- 19 commissioner or county clerk.
- 20 (b) If the ballot is to be returned by someone other than the voter
- 21 and the person returning the ballot does not reside in the same household
- 22 as the voter, the person returning the ballot shall do so within one
- 23 <u>business day after receiving the ballot from the voter unless the voter</u>
- 24 resides in a county that provides for twenty-four-hour drop-off of
- 25 ballots. If the voter resides in a county that provides for twenty-four-
- 26 hour drop-off of ballots, the ballot is to be returned by someone other
- 27 than the voter, and the person returning the ballot does not reside in
- 28 the same household as the voter, the person returning the ballot shall
- 29 return the ballot on the same calendar day that the ballot was received
- 30 <u>from the voter by the person returning the ballot.</u>
- 31 (4) The election commissioner or county clerk shall also enclose

- 1 with the ballot materials:
- 2 (a) A registration application, if the election commissioner or
- 3 county clerk has determined that the applicant is not a registered voter
- 4 pursuant to section 32-945, with instructions that failure to return the
- 5 completed and signed application indicating the residence address as it
- 6 appears on the voter's request for a ballot to the election commissioner
- 7 or county clerk by the close of the polls on election day will result in
- 8 the ballot not being counted;
- 9 (b) A registration application and the oath pursuant to section
- 10 32-946, if the voter is without a residence address, with instructions
- 11 that the residence address of the voter shall be deemed that of the
- 12 office of the election commissioner or county clerk of the county of the
- 13 voter's prior residence and that failure to return the completed and
- 14 signed application and oath to the election commissioner or county clerk
- 15 by the close of the polls on election day will result in the ballot not
- 16 being counted; or
- 17 (c) Written instructions directing the voter to submit a copy of an
- 18 identification document pursuant to section 32-318.01 if the voter is
- 19 required to present identification under such section and advising the
- 20 voter that failure to submit identification to the election commissioner
- 21 or county clerk by the close of the polls on election day will result in
- 22 the ballot not being counted.
- 23 (5) The election commissioner or county clerk may enclose with the
- 24 ballot materials a separate return envelope for the voter's use in
- 25 returning his or her identification envelope containing the voted ballot,
- 26 registration application, and other materials that may be required.
- 27 Sec. 2. Section 32-1535, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 28 amended to read:
- 29 32-1535 (1) Any person who removes any ballot from the polling room
- 30 before the closing of the polls except as otherwise authorized under the
- 31 Election Act shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.

- 1 (2) Any person who is returning a ballot for early voting on behalf
- 2 <u>of another person and who fails to comply with subsection (3) of section</u>
- 3 32-947 shall be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor.
