**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 470 allows keno to be played with electronic tickets, but would still require paper tickets to be available at the request of the player. The licensee would be required to take reasonable measures to limit electronic play to the licensed premises. For example, geofencing could be utilized as an electronic “fence” that would prevent a player from accessing the keno game outside of the licensed premises.

LB 470 also allows players to purchase tickets with means other than cash and it reduces the mandatory five-minute wait time between keno games to four minutes.
