13          Sec. 3. Former military vehicle means a motor vehicle that was  
14 manufactured for use in any country's military forces and is maintained  
15 to accurately represent its military design and markings, regardless of  
16 the vehicle's size or weight, but is no longer used, or never was used,  
17 by a military force.

18          Sec. 4. The owner of a former military vehicle may apply for a  
19 certificate of title by presenting (1) a manufacturer's certificate of  
20 origin, (2) a certificate of title from another state, (3) a court order  
21 issued by a court of record, (3) an assigned registration certificate, if  
22 the law of the state from which the vehicle was brought into this state  
23 does not require a certificate of title, (4) a United States Government  
24 Certificate to Obtain Title to a Vehicle, or (5) evidence of ownership as  
25 provided for in section 30-24,125, sections 52-601.01 to 52-605, sections  
26 60-1901 to 60-1911, or sections 60-2401 to 60-2411, or documentation of  
27 compliance with section 76-1607.

1           Sec. 5. Section 60-153, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
2 2018, is amended to read:

3           60-153 (1) A certificate of title shall be printed upon safety  
4 security paper to be selected by the department. The certificate of  
5 title, manufacturer's statement of origin, and assignment of  
6 manufacturer's certificate shall be upon forms prescribed by the  
7 department and may include, but shall not be limited to, county of  
8 issuance, date of issuance, certificate of title number, previous  
9 certificate of title number, vehicle identification number, year, make,  
10 model, and body type of the vehicle, name and residential and mailing  
11 address of the owner, acquisition date, issuing county treasurer's  
12 signature and official seal, and sufficient space for the notation and  
13 release of liens, mortgages, or encumbrances, if any. A certificate of  
14 title issued on or after September 1, 2007, shall include the words "void  
15 if altered". A certificate of title that is altered shall be deemed a  
16 mutilated certificate of title. The certificate of title of an all-  
17 terrain vehicle, utility-type vehicle, or minibike shall include the  
18 words "not to be registered for road use".

19           (2) An assignment of certificate of title shall appear on each  
20 certificate of title and shall include, but not be limited to, a  
21 statement that the owner of the vehicle assigns all his or her right,  
22 title, and interest in the vehicle, the name and address of the assignee,  
23 the name and address of the lienholder or secured party, if any, and the  
24 signature of the owner or the owner's parent, legal guardian, foster  
25 parent, or agent in the case of an owner who is a handicapped or disabled  
26 person as defined in section 60-331.02.

27           (3) A reassignment by a dealer shall appear on each certificate of  
28 title and shall include, but not be limited to, a statement that the  
29 dealer assigns all his or her right, title, and interest in the vehicle,  
30 the name and address of the assignee, the name and address of the  
31 lienholder or secured party, if any, and the signature of the dealer or

1 designated representative. Reassignments shall be printed on the reverse  
2 side of each certificate of title as many times as convenient.

3 (4) The department may prescribe a secure power-of-attorney form and  
4 may contract with one or more persons to develop, provide, sell, and  
5 distribute secure power-of-attorney forms in the manner authorized or  
6 required by the federal Truth in Mileage Act of 1986 and any other  
7 federal law or regulation. Any secure power-of-attorney form authorized  
8 pursuant to a contract shall conform to the terms of the contract and be  
9 in strict compliance with the requirements of the department.

11 vehicle tax shall be reduced by twenty-five percent.

13 2018, is amended to read:

14 60-3,190 (1) A motor vehicle fee is imposed on all motor vehicles  
15 registered for operation in this state. An owner of a motor vehicle which  
16 is exempt from the imposition of a motor vehicle tax pursuant to section  
17 60-3,185 shall also be exempt from the imposition of the motor vehicle  
18 fee imposed pursuant to this section.

19 (2) The department shall annually determine the motor vehicle fee on  
20 each motor vehicle registered pursuant to this section and shall cause a  
21 notice of the amount to be delivered to the registrant. The notice shall  
22 be combined with the notice of the motor vehicle tax required by section  
23 60-3,186.

24 (3) The motor vehicle fee schedules are set out in this subsection  
25 and subsection (4) of this section. Except for automobiles with a value  
26 when new of less than \$20,000, and for assembled, reconstructed-  
27 designated, and replica-designated automobiles, the fee shall be  
28 calculated by multiplying the base fee times the fraction which  
29 corresponds to the age category of the automobile as shown in the  
30 following table:

20 (5) The motor vehicle tax, motor vehicle fee, and registration fee  
21 shall be paid to the county treasurer prior to the registration of the  
22 motor vehicle for the following registration period. After retaining one  
23 percent of the motor vehicle fee collected for costs, the remaining  
24 proceeds shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Motor  
25 Vehicle Fee Fund. The State Treasurer shall return funds from the Motor  
26 Vehicle Fee Fund remitted by a county treasurer which are needed for  
27 refunds or credits authorized by law.

28 (6)(a) The Motor Vehicle Fee Fund is created. On or before the last  
29 day of each calendar quarter, the State Treasurer shall distribute all  
30 funds in the Motor Vehicle Fee Fund as follows: (i) Fifty percent to the

1 county treasurer of each county, amounts in the same proportion as the  
2 most recent allocation received by each county from the Highway  
3 Allocation Fund; and (ii) fifty percent to the treasurer of each  
4 municipality, amounts in the same proportion as the most recent  
5 allocation received by each municipality from the Highway Allocation  
6 Fund. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by  
7 the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion  
8 Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

9 (b) Funds from the Motor Vehicle Fee Fund shall be considered local  
10 revenue available for matching state sources.

11 (c) All receipts by counties and municipalities from the Motor  
12 Vehicle Fee Fund shall be used for road, bridge, and street purposes.

13 (7) For purposes of subdivisions (4)(a), (b), (c), and (f) of this  
14 section, automobiles or trucks includes all trucks and combinations of  
15 trucks or truck-tractors, except those trucks, trailers, or semitrailers  
16 registered under section 60-3,198, and the fee is based on the gross  
17 vehicle weight rating as reported by the manufacturer.

18 (8) Current model year vehicles are designated as first-year motor  
19 vehicles for purposes of the schedules.

20 (9) When a motor vehicle is registered which is newer than the  
21 current model year by the manufacturer's designation, the motor vehicle  
22 is subject to the initial motor vehicle fee for six registration periods.

23 (10) Assembled vehicles other than assembled, reconstructed-  
24 designated, or replica-designated automobiles shall follow the schedules  
25 for the motor vehicle body type.

11 less, (d) travels on four or more tires, (e) has a top speed of  
12 approximately fifty-five miles per hour, (f) is equipped with a bed or  
13 compartment for hauling, (g) has an enclosed passenger cab, (h) is  
14 equipped with headlights, taillights, turnsignals, windshield wipers, a  
15 rearview mirror, and an occupant protection system, and (i) has a four-  
16 speed, five-speed, or automatic transmission;
