The following changes, required to be reported for publication in the Journal, have been made:

1. On page 1, the matter beginning with "the" in line 1 through line 7 and all amendments thereto have been struck and "criminal justice; to amend sections 29-2202, 29-2246, and 29-2268, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 28-101, 28-105, 28-1206, 29-1823, 29-3523, 83-173.03, and 83-4,114, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change Class IV felony provisions; to prohibit the introduction and possession of electronic communication devices in correctional facilities as prescribed; to provide a penalty; to change possession of a deadly weapon by a prohibited person provisions; to change provisions relating to competency to stand trial; to provide for deferred judgments by courts as prescribed; to change provisions relating to post-release supervision; to prohibit placement of members of vulnerable populations in restrictive housing as prescribed; to change provisions relating to the long-term restrictive housing work group; to harmonize provisions; to provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes; and to repeal the original sections." inserted.
