Section 29-4108 provides that DNA samples and records submitted to the State DNA Sample Bank or State DNA Data Base are confidential, but shall be provided to law enforcement agencies and the forensic DNA laboratories that serve such agencies. LB106 would add additional language to clarify that the forensic DNA laboratories must participate in the Combined DNA Index System.
