Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would amend sections 44-3302 and 44-3303 of the statutes which govern legal expense insurance, sections 44-3301 to 44-3327, to provide that the insurance laws of this state do not apply to plans that do not include the assumption of risk or obligation to pay or reimburse for specified legal services or specified legal expenses, and that the payment of only an administrative fee to an attorney shall not be considered payment or reimbursement for specified legal services or a specified legal expense.
